ITEM 1 – REVIEW OF 2020-2021 BUDGET TO BE PROPOSED

The Council reviewed and discussed proposed expenditures and projected revenues to be included in the 2020-2021 Proposed Budget, which includes one new Police Officer beginning in January 2021, one replacement Police Officer to be filled in January 2021, and an increase in employee contribution rate to the Texas Municipal Retirement System (TMRS) from 6% to the maximum 7% as authorized by State Statutes.
